- Vocabulary building and language development through the story of 'The Owl babies' along with read aloud, mark making, enactment and retell was done.

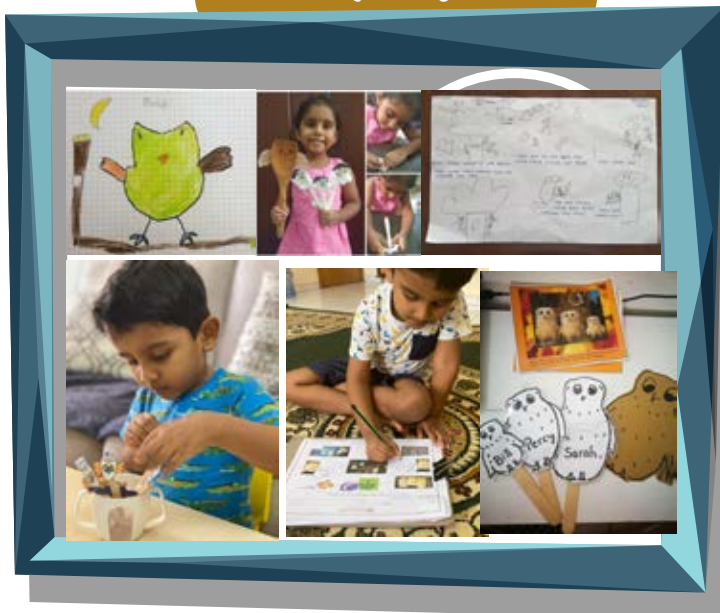
