It is amazing to see great development in my students' understanding from writing letters to creative their own sentences.










In Literacy, it was all about phonics and sounds of letters along with vocabulary building through complex words.




Literacy activities engaged them with Opinion writing skills.



Activity: Learners discuss the importance of saving water, electricity, food and other natural resources. (For e.g. make a poster titled SAVE WATER IN THE LIAE).









OIAM SPECIAL

Art had our students learn Step by Step drawing related to different shapes.


Library had loads of fictional, non-fictional and interactive story time enhancing language, imagination and listening.


